A 38 year old Duluth man died after being electrocuted in a construction accident. The man was working at a home in the 1500 block of North 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue East when the accident occurred. Duluth Police, along with Duluth Fire and Gold Cross Ambulance, were called to the scene and found the man unconscious, not breathing and without a pulse. CPR was started and the man was transported by ambulance to Essentia Health- St. Mary's Medical Center where he was pronounced dead.

The cause of the accident is under investigation. The man's identity is being withheld pending notification of family.
