On Thursday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at 3:28 PM Duluth Police were called to the report of a shooting that occurred at a residence in the 200 block of East 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

Officers arrived and found a 48 year old female resident with an apparent gunshot wound to the chest. She was transported to Essentia St. Mary's hospital for her injury and she is now listed in stable condition.

Officers located the suspect, a 70 year old male resident outside and he was taken into custody. The victim and suspect were both known to each other.

**UPDATE:**

**The victim has been identified as Betty Jean Grigsby, a 48 year old female. She remains at St. Mary's hospital in stable condition.**

**The suspect has been identified as Helge (no middle name) Rohm, a 70 year old male. He was arrested and transported to the Saint Louis County Jail for 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Attempted Murder and 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault. Formal charges are expected next week.**
